Conducting site inspections. Investigating and ensuring appropriate follow-up of ambient air quality complaints and / or complaints in respect of listed activities and controlled emitters. • Providing specialist input in internal District processes, during the formulation and implementation of legislation, policies, codes of practice, performance management policy, and ambient air quality standards. • Liaising with Municipal owned entities with regard to the air quality impacts of their operations. • Participating in the development, review, and implementation of the Air Pollution Control By-laws of the District. • Providing specialist air quality input in Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) review processes, development application processes, including the District planning process. • Participating in meetings/forums between all stakeholders. Assisting in the design of and participate in the implementation of air quality awareness campaign(s). • Assisting in the design and implementation of the air quality management and emission reduction programmers of the District. Implementing policies and strategies relating to best practice in the Business Unit.


